




• Our focus: what needs to happen so that:

All rising 6th graders will have the support to reach critical milestones so that they are prepared for successful transition into middle school and, ultimately, to be college and career ready



• We're about making sure Maine children have support from their earliest days

Expand access for all children ages 6 weeks to 5 years by increasing access to Early Head Start, Head Start and other affordable, high quality learning environments so that any parent who wants to enroll their child is able to do so.

• We're about making sure students build proficiency to support future success

Elevate the importance of proficiency in Reading and Math, as well as Maine's Guiding Principles, and develop and deploy supports for schools to help improve proficiency across all learning standards and content areas for their students.

• We're about weaving the pieces together

Create a coordinated educational pipeline from Birth through Grade 6 by creating policies that support common screenings, assessments, and evidence-based curricula in the early care and public education system.

• We're about supporting families, so they can support their children

Maine state and local systems have familyfriendly policies and implementation strategies that strengthen families so they can support their children in reaching critical milestones by increasing the value of childcare subsidies and streamlining the process for accessing these subsidies.
